So many times, we have heard a pope give marching orders to **"the whole of Christendom"** as if he is in charge of the protestants also?

...3. The famous Sanctuary Santiago de Compostela, Spain, will be a very important point of reference for the celebration of this Day 1989. As I have already told you, after the ordinary celebration of your feast - Palm Sunday - in the particular Churches, I give you rendez-vous at the Sanctuary; I will go there, a pilgrim like yourselves, for the 19th and 20th August 1989. I am sure you will not fail to respond to my invitation, as you did not fail for the unforgettable meeting in Buenos Aires, in 1987.

The appointment at Santiago will in any case be a moment of participation for the whole of the Universal Church; a moment of spiritual communion even for those among you who will not be able to be physically present. At Santiago the young people will indeed represent the particular Churches of the whole world; you will all be heirs to the "Santiago Trail" with the urge to proclaim the Good News.

Santiago de Compostela is a place that has played a very important role in the history of Christianity; and so, its spiritual message is in itself very eloquent. Throughout the centuries the place has been a "point of attraction and convergence for Europe and for <u>the whole of</u> <u>Christendom</u>... all Europe gathered around the 'memory' of James during the very centuries when it was building itself into a homogeneous and spiritually united continent" (cfr. *"European Act"* at Santiago de Compostela, 9 November 1982, in *Insegnamenti* V/3, 1982, pp. 1257-1258)...

<u>National Catholic Reporter</u> 'Christendom no longer exists,' pope says, explaining need to revamp Curia.



Pope Francis speaks during his annual audience to give Christmas greetings to members of the Roman Curia at the Vatican Dec. 21, 2019.

...As he has often done, Pope Francis quoted the 19th-century composer Gustav Mahler, who said, "Tradition is not the worship of ashes, but the preservation of fire."

The pope discussed the changes proposed for the doctrinal congregation and the Congregation for the Evangelization of Peoples, the large Curia office that supports and oversees church efforts in lands traditionally known as "missionary territory" -- like Africa and Asia.

The two congregations, he said, were instituted "in an age when it was easier to distinguish between two fairly well-defined shores: a Christian world on one side and a world still to be evangelized on the other."

"This situation no longer exists," the pope said.

"In fact," he said, "the populations that still have not received the proclamation of the Gospel do not live only on non-Western continents, but live everywhere, especially in the large urban concentrations, which require their own specific pastoral work."

"Christendom no longer exists," he said. <u>"Today we are not the only ones who produce</u> culture, nor are we the first or the most listened to."

<u>Christianity, "especially in Europe, but also in a large part of the West, is no longer an</u> <u>obvious premise of our common life, but rather it is often denied, derided, marginalized</u> <u>or ridiculed."</u>

Evangelization and the "new evangelization" St. John Paul II called for are urgent needs, the pope said, which is why **the Curia itself must change and adapt**...

So, if they created this "organized religion" thing called "Christianity" (whether Catholic or Protestant), so then why can't they change the membership rules? They also created pagan Christmas, so now "Christians" defend Christmas as "Christian" in the public square, and "they" sit back and laugh at all the division and hate they created...and none of this is THE WAY. Acts 24:14..."according to **the Way** which they call a sect."

Now even though they are bounty hunters they always seem to do the right and moral thing...and I am not saying the book of Acts is anything like this show. When I listened to episode 118 of "The Flat Earth Files" with Brandon, that struck a chord about the Mandalorian series when he was talking about Alice in wonderland.

So, my "Christianity theory" has been developing a little further. This is from the first hit on Google and it was from PBS, about "Christianity" and the Roman Empire:

*"In 313 AD, the Emperor Constantine issued the Edict of Milan, which accepted Christianity: 10 years later, it had become the official religion of the Roman Empire."* 

I find this interesting, so am I hearing...state-controlled religion?

Now with just a little more info I think I can build my hypothesis. So, in Acts we meet Simon Magus...I will use the Geneva Bible because the commentary can be insightful.

## Acts 8:9-25, 1599 Geneva Bible

<sup>9</sup>[a]And there was before in the city, a certain man called **Simon**, which used **D**witchcraft, and [c]bewitched the people of Samaria, saying that he himself was some great man, <sup>10</sup> To whom they gave heed from the least to the greatest, saying, This man is that great power of God. <sup>11</sup> And they gave heed unto him, because that of long time he had bewitched them with sorceries. <sup>12</sup> But as soon as they believed Philip, which preached the things that concerned the kingdom of God, and the Name of Jesus Christ, they were baptized both men and women. <sup>13</sup> [d] Then <u>Simon</u> himself believed also, and was baptized, and continued with Philip, and wondered, when he saw the signs and great miracles which were done. <sup>14</sup>¶ [e]Now when the Apostles, which were at Jerusalem, heard say, that Samaria had received the word of God, they sent unto them Peter and John. <sup>15</sup> Which when they were come down, prayed for them, that they might receive the Inholy Ghost. <sup>16</sup> (For as yet he was fallen down on none of them, but they were baptized only in the Name of the Lord Jesus.) <sup>17</sup> Then laid they their hands on them, and they received the holy Ghost. <sup>18</sup> [g]And when **Simon** saw that through laying on of the Apostles' hands the holy Ghost was given, he offered them money, <sup>19</sup> Saying, Give me also this power, that on whomsoever I lay the hands, he may receive the holy Ghost. <sup>20</sup> [h] Then said Peter unto him, Thy money perish with thee, because thou thinkest that the gift of God may be obtained with money. <sup>21</sup> Thou hast neither part nor fellowship in this ibusiness: for thine heart is not iright in the sight of God. <sup>22</sup> k Repent therefore of this thy wickedness, and pray God, that if it be possible, the thought of thine heart may be forgiven thee. <sup>23</sup> For I see that thou art in the [l]gall of bitterness, and in the [m]bond of iniquity. <sup>24</sup> Then answered **Simon**, and said, **Pray ve to the Lord for me**, that none of these things which ye have spoken, come upon me. <sup>25</sup>¶ So they, when they had testified and preached the word of the Lord, returned to Jerusalem, and preached the Gospel in many towns of the Samaritans.

#### Footnotes

- a. <u>Acts 8:9</u> Christ overcometh Satan so oft as he listeth, and carrieth him about as it were in a triumph in the sight of them, whom he deceived and bewitched.
- b. <u>Acts 8:9</u> The word which is used in this place was at the first taken in good part, and is borrowed out of the Persians' language, who call their wise men by that name, but afterward it was taken in evil part.
- c. <u>Acts 8:9</u> He had so allured the Samaritans with his witchcrafts, that as blind and mad harebrains they were wholly addicted to him.
- d. <u>Acts 8:13</u> The wicked and the very reprobate are constrained oftentimes to taste of the good gift of God, but they cast it up again forthwith.

- e. <u>Acts 8:14</u> Peter not chief, but as an ambassador sent from the whole company of the Apostles, and John his companion according to the authority which was committed unto them, confirm and build up the Churches of Samaria, whose foundation had been laid afore by Philip.
- f. <u>Acts 8:15</u> Those excellent gifts, which are necessary, especially for them that were to be appointed rulers and governors of the Church.

- 1. <u>Acts 8:23</u> He calleth the inward malice of the heart, and that venomous and devilish wickedness wherewith this Magician was wholly replenished, the gall of bitterness: and he is said to be in the gall as though he were wholly overwhelmed with gall, and buried in it.

So, to shorten this up I will jump to the end, and you can research this part for the facts on your own...there is basically enough in the commentary here. In these passages we see Simon Peter meeting the first pope Simon "Peter", if you didn't know this, this magician was the unofficial start of the papacy and Catholicism. Then I also noticed that Simon Magus never repented as he was directed to do by Peter & John, instead he asks them to pray for him, Ahhh...no one else can repent for us but ourselves. Instead he started a "religion" revolving around doctrines of men, holy artifacts, money, and magic.

The last few years have taught us about "pharmakeia" (sorceries) in Revelation 18:23 which is our English word "pharmaceuticals". The English word for sorceries used here in Acts is a different Greek word, according to Strongs? But if we read these verses about this Simon Magus, he does sound like an Anothony Fauci being a drug pusher/bewitching people though? Here is a "sorcery" verse I thought was fitting for this pope Simon Magus guy and his lack of repentance

## **Revelation 9:21**

Also they **<u>repented not</u>** of their murder, and of their **<u>sorcery</u>**, neither of their fornication, nor of their theft.

So, my hypothesis is that Simon Magus started his cult and called it "Christianity", which might be why it was a derogatory term...derogatory from the followers of "The Way" which was handing down from "<u>the Way</u>, the Truth, and the Life" to the Apostles. In the past I always thought these warnings were for the future in dark times, but I know now that these warnings were reality from the time, they penned them to the end of the age. Back then they were helping people on turning back to what they came from, now it seems so many want to go way back from were those people came from. Now we have the evidence of the past and what they had outcome...but hardly any listeners<sup>®</sup> Especially from those we call "Christians"?

# 2 Corinthians 11:4

For if he that cometh, preacheth another Jesus whom we have not preached: or if ye receive another spirit whom ye have not received: either another Gospel which ye have not received, ye might well have suffered *him*.

Hmmm, another Jesus, another spirit, or another gospel...who preaches that? - f. <u>2 Peter 1:20</u> He joineth the Scripture and prophecy together to distinguish true prophecies from false.
- g. <u>2 Peter 1:20</u> For all interpretation cometh from God.
- h. <u>2 Peter 1:21</u> The godly interpreters and messengers.

i. <u>2 Peter 1:21</u> Inspired of God: and these their motions were in very good order, and not such as were the motions of the profane soothsayers, and foretellers of things to come.

This is what my point about "The Way" instead of "Christianity" is, the bible is referring to "the Elect" and it is also telling us to "come out of her", I think "the Elect" are the true "protesters" (protestants) they "come out HER" (the harlot has daughters that came out of her, as he pope says when he talks to "ALL of "Christendom") and follow "The Way" (Christ, and His teachings ONLY). We wonder why there are so many denominations. Could it be we are fighting the wrong fight? Could we have been trying to cure the symptoms and not the disease? Could we have been deceived? # Mark 13:22

#### Colossians 3:12

Put on therefore, as the elect of God, holy and beloved, bowels of mercies, kindness, humbleness of mind, meekness, longsuffering;

According to the word of God, I don't believe the true elect can be deceived (at least not for long) because like the Bereans they keep searching for truth. Now when I say "Christianity" is a deception, I am not referring to followers of Christ, but I am talking about "religion" which is just men retelling or rearranging Gods words with a touch of truth, but has nothing to do with God at all, its "another Gospel". <sup>13</sup> [d]For this cause take unto you the whole armor of God, that ye may be able to resist in the [e]evil day, and having finished all things, stand fast.

- a. <u>Ephesians 6:12</u> Secondly he declareth that our chiefest and mightiest enemies are invisible, that we may not think that our chiefest conflict is with men.
- b. <u>Ephesians 6:12</u> Against men, which are of a frail and brittle nature, against which are set spiritual subtleties, more mighty than the other by a thousand parts.
- c. <u>Ephesians 6:12</u> He giveth these names to the evil angels, reason of the effects which they work: not that they are able to do the same of themselves, but because God giveth them the bridle.
- d. <u>Ephesians 6:13</u> He showeth that these enemies are put to flight with the only armor of God, to wit, with uprightness of conscience, a godly and holy life, knowledge of the Gospel, faith, and to be short, with the word of God, and using daily earnest prayer for the health of the Church, and especially, for the constance of the true, godly, and valiant ministers of the word.
- e. Ephesians 6:13 See Eph. 5:16.
